OPEN BOARD OF DIRECTOR POSITIONS


As of June 30th several positions on the Board of Directors of SNN will be open and need to be filled for a TWO YEAR term (July 1, 2024 - June 30, 2026).




Gentlemen's Book Club


Visit to the New Bedford Whaling Museum Wednesday, April 10th at 10:45 am

On April 10th, we are planning a visit to the New Bedford Whaling Museum, the largest museum in America devoted to human interaction with whales, the history of whaling, and the history of the Southeast Coast of Massachusetts. We will be treated to a private group tour beginning at 10:45 a.m. followed by a 3-D movie entitled "Ocean Odyssey". After the movie, we will meet for lunch at Tia Maria's European Cafe which is located in the heart of the National Historical Whaling Park.
